COVID-19 Measures

When attending an AWBF performance at Theatre Aurora, patrons can feel safe and comfortable knowing that we are taking measures to protect you and our community.

As of September 22, the Ontario Government requires individuals over the age of 12 to be fully vaccinated and provide their paper or digital proof of vaccination status, along with photo ID, to attend performances. In line with this protocol, patrons of the AWBF at Theatre Aurora must show proof of vaccination or exemption upon entry. When you come to the Theatre, please bring:

- Government-issued photo ID
- Record of vaccination or letter of medical exemption. Records may be provided on paper or on your phone.
- Tickets
- Mask

On October 9, 2021, the Ontario Government with the advice of the Chief Medical Officer of Health announced a lifting of capacity limits to allow for 100 percent capacity for select indoor and outdoor settings where proof of vaccination is required. This includes concert venues, theatres, and cinemas.

The AWBF and Theatre Aurora, will be allowing all shows to be sold at 100 percent capacity with no physical distancing though Masking is required for all shows.

We will continue to observe all provincial-mandated safety protocols and do everything we can to provide a safe and meaningful return to the AWBF at Theatre Aurora. All visitors will be required to follow these additional safety requirements:

Answer screening questions from our volunteer staff;

Sanitize hands upon entry; and

Always wear a mask.

Health Screening:

Anyone experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 or advised by Public Health to self-isolate may not enter Theatre Aurora. If you are unable to attend a performance for these reasons, please contact Music Aurora by e-mail at info@musicaurora.ca before the show.
